Celebrated 2nd Anniversary of Rhonda's Promise in front of 55 amazing women at the Tealicious Tea Party.

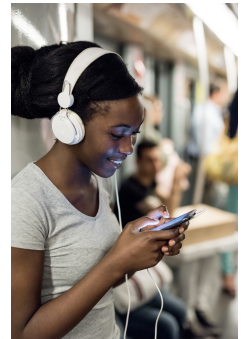
June 25, 2023

Received a mini-grant from Healthier Boynton Beach in the amount of \$3000 for Hey Sistas Mental Health Awareness program and support group.



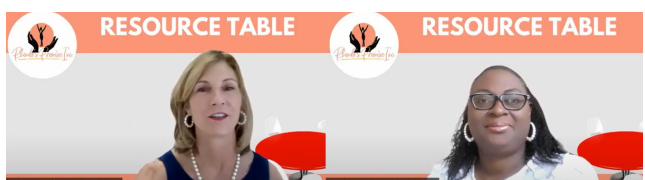
January 26, 2023

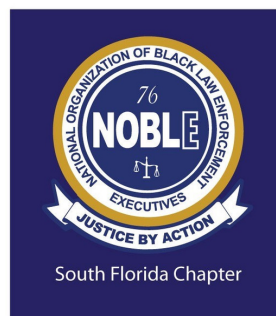
